ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Church Street Waterline Replacement** project will be received by the **Town of Central, SC**, at Central City Hall located at 1067 West Main Street, Central, SC 29630, until **2:00 pm** local time on **June 7th, 2022** at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project generally consists of approximately 5,405 LF of 8" waterline, 300 LF of 6" waterline 1,490 LF of 2" waterline, 3 fire hydrant assemblies, service reconnections, and associated work tasks for a complete and proper installation.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated on the Bid Form.

Only those contract drawings, specifications, and bid documents obtained from the Engineer (or from QuestCDN) are official. Bidders cannot rely on the accuracy of copies of the aforementioned documents, drawings, specifications, etc. obtained from any other source. Bidder's must be on the Engineer's official plan holders list for the bids to be accepted by the Owner.

Bidders must deposit security with all bids. Security shall be in the form of a certified check or bid bond made payable to the Owner and shall be for an amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid. Provisions of the security shall be as described in the Information for Bidders.

Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the amount of 100% of the contract price will be required of the successful bidder.

Funding for the project shall be provided via grant from the S.C. Department of Commerce (CDBG Program), loan from the SC State Revolving Fund (SRF), and local match funding provided by the Town of Central.

This project is being funded in part by a loan from the SC State Revolving Fund. Bidders must comply with all applicable state and federal requirements identified in the bid documents including, but not limited to, Davis-Bacon wage rates and American Iron and Steel Provisions.

This project is also being funded in whole or in part by the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). All federal CDBG requirements will apply to the contract. **All contractors and subcontractors are required to be registered in the federal System for Award Management (SAM).** Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 & Order No. 11375 which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and 40 CFR 33.240.

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Bidders must also make positive efforts to use small and minority-owned business and to offer employment, training and contracting opportunities in accordance with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968. Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

No bid will be considered unless the bidder is legally qualified under the provisions of the South Carolina Contractor's Licensing Law (South Carolina Code of Laws as amended on April 1, 1999, Chapter 11, Sections 40-11-10 through 40-11-428). Contractors shall have a classification of WL.

All bidders are advised that the grant application with cost estimate is available for review. The Owner reserves the right to waive any irregularities, or to reject any or all bids. Bids may be held by the Owner for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of the opening of bids.
