Water Conservation in the home- In 2024 each month we will have a water conservation tip that might help reduce your water bill. This month's tip is for Outside use. Use a hose nozzle that you can shut off or adjust to a fine spray. When finished, shut it off at the house to avoid leaks. Also check hoses and connectors, replace any leaky parts or sections.
