Overbrook Community Foundation Grant - The Overbrook Community Foundation is thrilled to announce that it was chosen again as a recipient of the Patterson Family Foundation Rural Community Foundation Match Program for 2024. In partnership with the Kansas Association of Community Foundations (KACF), the Patterson Family Foundation will again provide up to \$70,000 in matching funds to qualifying community foundations to support their match events (not to exceed thirty days). This initiative is designed to stimulate local philanthropy within rural areas of Kansas and northwestern Missouri communities.

Applications are available at Overbrook City Hall on May 1, 2024, and are due on or before June 1, 2024. Completed applications should be submitted to Overbrook Community Foundation, P.O. Box 8, Overbrook, KS 66524. Selected recipients are responsible for fundraising to be matched dollar for dollar. Match funds may be allocated at the discretion of the community foundation's leadership. Recipients to be announced June 17, 2024.

Water Conservation in the home- In 2024 each month we will have a water conservation tip that might help reduce your water bill. This month's tip is for Outside use. Don't Run the Hose While Washing Your Car: Clean the car using a pail of soapy water. Use the hose only for rinsing; this simple practice can save as much as 100 gallons when washing a car. Use a spray nozzle when rinsing for more efficient use of water.
