## **Traffic Citation information**

### **CURRENT CITATION**

Current traffic citations (from July 2018 to current date) can be paid by logging on to [quickcourt.biz/washington](http://quickcourt.biz/washington). Information regarding the citation is also available on the website. Fines may also be paid at [townofwashingtonpayments.com](http://townofwashingtonpayments.com) or by calling 800-701-8560.

After verifying amount online, payment may also be mailed (cashiers' check or money order payable to Town of Washington with citation # written in memo section) to: Town of Washington, PO Box 218, Washington, LA 70589.

### **NON-CURRENT CITATION**

Traffic citations issued prior to July 2018 are handled by American Municipal Services (AMS) @ 800-555-5160. All citations turned over to AMS must be handled by AMS and not the Town of Washington. Customer support can be reached by dialing 337-310-4202 and asking for Steven.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

A citation can only be contested in person, on the specified court date. The court date is printed on the bottom portion of the citation. Court is held the third Monday of each month at 5:00 PM. The address is 405 N. Washington St, Washington, LA. There is no provision to reschedule a court date. ### **SUSPENDED LICENSES**

If payment is not received, licenses are suspended 30 days after the court date. Once a citation is paid, communication is provided to Louisiana Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to unsuspend the license. Once this notification is received by DMV, it is up to the license holder to visit DMV and pay the license reinstatement fee.
