Dear Property Owner/Resident/Occupant

The City of Blue Ridge has attained a grant through the Texas Department of Agriculture to improve the sewer line in the northern area of our City. Through the grant, we have contracted with Canary Construction who will be performing the work. The sewer project will consist of installing a sewer line along Baker Street heading North, then turn along an easement on the Blue Ridge ISD property to connect to North Church. North Church will be affected to West Lamm Street. Other residential streets affected will be Dunn Street, Davis Street and Richardson Street. The sewer improvement project which will be under construction beginning May 3, 2021 and is scheduled to be completed by August 30, 2021.

Due to the area affected, we have requested the Contractor work around the school area after school is out for the summer. See the map of the areas affected on the next page.

Due to the sewer lines being located under the streets, this also means we will be redoing the streets in this project. Thank you for your patience during the construction process. The plan is to have everything completed by August 30, 2021. All affected residential streets will be available to residents only and not thru traffic.
