Boat Steward

Part-Time Position

The Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District is searching for an *energetic*, customer service minded individual to work as a Watercraft Steward in our relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

Primary Responsibilities:

- 1. Manage the overall CSCD Zebra Mussel Prevention Program, ideally, over a 2-year period from April 1st through October 31st each year with the primary goal of inspecting ALL watercraft and trailers launching at the Sweetwater and Cordry boat ramps.
- 2. Identify, locate, train, and manage a robust team of volunteer boat stewards to assist in maintaining an 18 hour-a-day/7 day-a week boat steward resource at both boat ramps while maintaining a daily inspection log.
- 3. Establish and operate a boat/trailer decontamination site using CSCD-provided supplies and equipment.
- 4. Train freeholders in the use of CSCD decontamination equipment located at the CSCD decontamination site for DIY decontamination operations.
- 5. Educate all transient boaters (freeholders/contractors/boat delivery personnel) on the dangers of and prevention of transported Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS)
- **6.** Ensure that all boat launches at each boat ramp are performed by authorized CSCD freeholders only, and that all boat launches are accomplished in a clean (no AIS) and efficient manner

Job Qualifications:

- 1. Knowledge of watercraft and related equipment or accessories.
- 2. Excellent interpersonal communication skills.
- 3. Ability to successfully and clearly present information to a diverse audience, and to react in a positive, proactive manner in confrontational circumstances.
- 4. Must have knowledge and experience in operation and maintenance of all equipment owned by CSCD.
- 5. Must have the ability to safely, efficiently, and effectively carry out the duties and responsibilities assigned under general supervision.
- 6. Must be 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- 7. Must have and maintain a valid driver's license.
- 8. Must pass a drug screening test.

Physical Demands Requirements:

- 1. Must be physically able to perform duties.
- 2. Must be able to stand and sit for long periods; must be able to lift and carry 50 pounds.

Working Conditions:

- 1. May be exposed to a variety of elements and weather conditions including long periods of sun exposure, rain, and wind.
- 2. Weekends, evenings, and Holidays may be included in your schedule.
