

PORTAGEVILLE TRASH COLLECTION SCHEDULE UPDATE

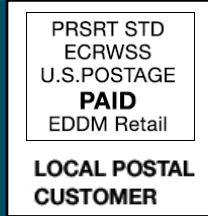

Sharp Disposal LLC officially took over trash services for the City of Portageville on September 6, 2022. After spending a few weeks learning the route, the Board of Alderman were approached with making some minor changes to the routes to be more effective.

While we are aware that it was previously stated that our intention was to wait until the new year to implement any changes, excessive fuel fees due to numerous landfill trips have caused us to reevaluate our timetable. Effective **October 1, 2022**, Sharp Disposal will pick up trash three days a week with Huffman Avenue dividing the town into two areas.

<u>LOCATION</u>	<u>TRASH COLLECTION DAY</u>
Residential Trash Collection:	
Huffman Avenue to the East	Monday Trash Service
Huffman Avenue to the West	Friday Trash Service
Non-Residential Dumpsters:	
One (1) Empty Per Week	Wednesday Trash Service
Two (2) Empties Per Week	Monday & Friday Trash Service
Three (3) Empties Per Week	Mon/ Wed/ Fri Trash Service
Residential Dumpsters will be emptied on the same day as residential trash service listed above.	

As a reminder, Senior Citizens needing extra help with trash collection can be put on a list so that their trash containers are collected, emptied, and replaced at no additional charge. If you or someone you know is in need of this service, please contact City Hall at 573-379-5789.

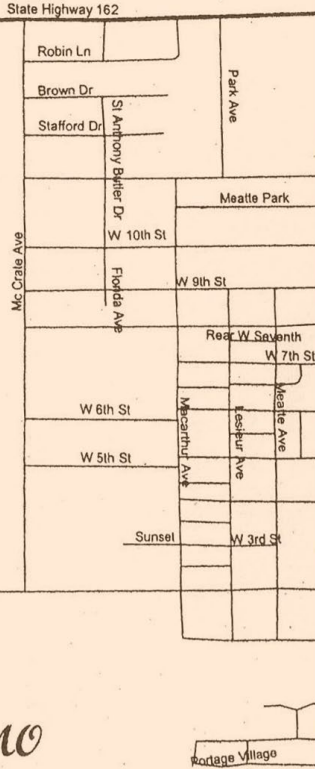

HUFFMAN AVENUE IS THE DIVIDING LINE

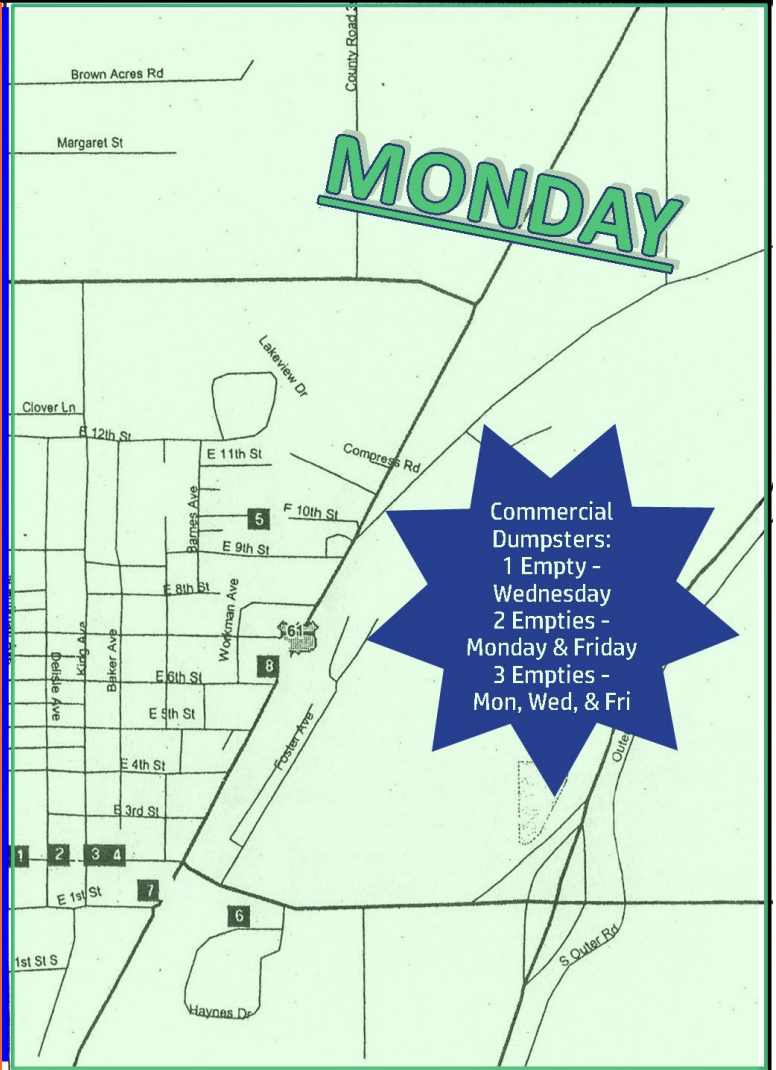

REMINDER OF COLLECTION RULES AND REGULATIONS

Sharp Disposal has agreed to the same collection rules and regulations that the City of Portageville already followed. Key points are listed below. The most frequently asked question is if you will have to buy new collection containers.

The answer is **NO**. If you **WOULD LIKE** to have a 96-gallon container, you do have the option to lease one in which a minimal fee will be added to your utility bill. **IT IS NOT REQUIRED**. If you would prefer to own a container instead of lease, Sharp Disposal sells these for \$100.00.

Containers should be watertight, galvanized metal or a durable plastic container equipped with a handle or handles to facilitating lifting, and a tight-fitting lid of a capacity of 30 gallons or less, which when containing solid waste, shall not weigh in excess of 75 pounds. All trash within the containers must be placed in bags!

Containers shall be placed at the curb for pickup after 5:00 p.m. on the **DAY BEFORE** pickup and the empty container should be replaced at the residence behind a fence within 24 hours after being emptied.

A listed of prohibited items can be found in Section 230.130 of the Municipal Code which is listed on our website. A hard copy can be requested at City Hall!
