Re: War Memorial Dedication Ceremony

On Saturday, May 29, 2021 the Carbon Cliff Board of Trustees will be unveiling, to the public, the recently renovated Carbon Cliff War Memorial. Previously, the War Memorial sat outside the old Village hall located at 106 1st Avenue. In December of 2017, the Village purchased 1001 Mansur Avenue and moved the Village Hall to this location with plans to move the memorial by the end of 2020. In 2019 the memorial was taken down to be restored, however, the memorial was too worn down and it was quickly decided that a completely new memorial would be the best way to honor the men and women who served our country. In 2020, COVID delayed many things including moving forward with the memorial. In March of 2021, the Village contracted Edwards Creative out of Milan, Illinois to redesign and construct the new memorial. The new memorial now resides inside the Council Members Board Room at our Village Hall. On Saturday, May 29, 2021, Memorial Day Weekend, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Carbon Cliff Village Hall, 1001 Mansur Avenue, Carbon Cliff, the Village invites the public to come down and see our new war memorial. The Village is also inviting those who have served, and have resided in Carbon Cliff, to submit their information to the Village so that we can update the memorial.
