Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of New Market, Iowa (the "City") on the proposed contract documents (plans, specifications and form of contract) and estimated cost for the construction of certain improvements and work incidental thereto described in general as "Water System Improvements – Division 2 – Booster Pump Station Improvements – New Market, Iowa - 2023" and as described in detail in the "Plans and Specifications" for said improvements now on file in City Hall, 512 Main Street, New Market, Iowa 51646 (the "Project").

The public hearing will be held at **7:00 P.M. on Thursday, January 18, 2024**, in City Hall, 512 Main Street, New Market, Iowa 51646 in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 384, Code of Iowa.

At said hearing any interested person may appear and file objections thereto or to the cost of the improvements or the Project. At the hearing, the City will receive and consider any objections made by any interested party, if any, to the Plans and Specifications, proposed form of contract and the estimate of cost for the Project. After hearing objections, the City will enter its decision on the Plans and Specifications, form of contract to be awarded, and cost for the Project.

<u>General Nature of Improvements</u>. The work, to take place west of the intersection of C Street and Fourth Street (southwest of the existing booster pump station) within City right-of-way, generally consists of the following:

<u>Division 2 – Booster Pump Station Improvements:</u> Lump sum price for furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and incidentals for the construction of a complete and operational Booster Pump Station as shown on plans and specifications; including but not limited to excavation, site work, 10 FT X 16 FT masonry block building, piping, valves, hydrants, two (2) 65 gpm 5 HP pumps with variable frequency drives, electrical service and systems, grounding, wiring and lighting, pressure transducer, HVAC, water main and connections, backfill, control system at booster pump station and water tower, demolition of existing booster pump station vault and piping, and miscellaneous associated work for complete installation.

American Iron and Steel

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A - Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project.
