

Population Surge

The population of the metroplex will likely swell considerably for a couple of days prior to the total solar eclipse on Monday, April 8, 2024. Plan for heavy traffic and long lines for local services such as restaurants, gas stations, grocery and retail stores. Do what you can ahead of time before the anticipated impact days and allow for extra time to get where you need to go.

Things to Consider for the Metroplex


- Avoid scheduling your errands and appointments the day of and weekend prior to the eclipse
 if possible.
- Check ahead if you have plans for Monday the 8th; some services may be closed or have limited hours during this time. (DWG City Hall front windows will be closed from 1-2pm.) By scheduling your errands early, you will beat the crowds and give our local stores and businesses time to restock before the eclipse visitors arrive.
- Overall, supplies may be limited due to high demand; which may mean the items you want are not available during the impact days. If there is something important you want, get it early
- With the increased number of visitors, local public safety officials anticipate cellular service
 may become overwhelmed (primarily Monday the 8th) or have limited access during the
 impact days.

Things to Consider for Attending the Event

- Eclipse Viewing Glasses
- Sunscreen
- First Aid Kit
- Necessary medications for you and your pets
- Cash or other payment methods
- Water (plenty of it)
- Sunglasses
- Hat/visor
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Folding chair or blanket
- Jacket or sweatshirt as needed for the weather forecast. April 8 can be chilly or hot.
- Maps of the area if you need directions (print your directions and bring them with you); your cellular service may be limited during heaviest impact times
