

# Stage III Drought Contingency and Emergency Water Demand Management Plan

Due to the failure of a major component of the water system, the City of Burton is entering into Stage III of our Emergency Water Demand Management Plan.

Stage III water allocation measures are as follows:

- a) System operators have diagnosed the issue and are actively working to remedy the issue.
- b) Flushing lines is prohibited except for dead end mains and only between the hours of 9pm and 3am.
- c) All meters will periodically be read to ensure compliance with this program for the benefit of all customers.
- d) Irrigation of landscaped areas is absolutely prohibited.
- e) Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, or other vehicle is absolutely prohibited.
- f) Use of water to fill swimming pools, flush gutters, or wash down sidewalks, buildings or structures, for purposed other than fire protection, is prohibited.

Consequences for violations of the above stipulations can be up to \$50 or discontinuation of service.

These restrictions will be in effect until further notice. An alert will be sent to notify you of when this implementation of Stage III is lifted.
