**FOUR FEMA DISASTER RECOVERY CENTERS SET TO OPEN THROUGHOUT THE
RIO GRANDE VALLEY TO ASSIST WITH MARCH 2025 FLOOD RECOVERY**

The Cameron County Judge's Office has received official confirmation from the Texas Division of Emergency Management that four FEMA Disaster Recovery Centers will open today, Tuesday, March 27, 2025, to assist residents impacted by the recent flooding. The centers will operate from **12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** on their opening day and will transition to regular hours of **8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** starting Wednesday, March 28, 2025. All centers will be open **seven days a week** to provide vital support and recovery assistance. The addresses of the four Disaster Recovery Centers are listed below:
