ATTENTION ALL WATER SUPPLY ENTITIES:

Status of U.S. ownership in Falcon and Amistad Reservoir System.

The TCEQ water master latest report for the Current Combined Capacity for the U.S. is **19.71%**.

Please review your Conservation Requirements for water usage in you City or Water Supply Organizations and enact the applicable restrictions. It is strongly advised that public and customer notice be given to so that water users are aware of the current in-force restrictions.

It is also advised that for those water utilities that depend on raw water delivery from an irrigation district that communication be established relating to any push water requirements that may be adjusted or implemented relating to the limitation of agriculture water because of the status of the reservoir levels.
