Homestead Assistance

The Labette County Clerk's Office will be available to assist in processing the Homestead/Safe Senior Property Tax Refund for Low Income Seniors/Senior Disabled Veterans.

Homestead: Renting does not qualify for the Homestead refund. You must be the homeowner, and you must be listed on the deed.

Total Household Income: must be \$42.600 or less to file a Homestead.

The Clerk's office will be available to assist applicants on the following days and times:

MONDAY – FRIDAY 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM THE DEADLINE TO FILE IS APRIL 15, 2025

Note: If this is your first time filing a homestead you will need to file by paper.

Below is the information we MUST have before we can process your claim.

- Your last year's refund amount (if applicable)
- Any And All Income For 2024 (All Income for any household member over the age of 18)
- Food Stamps and Cash Assistance for 2024 (if applicable)
- ❖ Social Security 1099 form the amount of Interest and Income you received in 2024
- Spouse & Dependents Social Security Numbers and DOB
- ❖ Tax Statement A copy of your Tax Statement for 2024
- ❖ If your claim will be directly deposited we will need banking information, you will have the option for a paper check to be mailed to you
- If you file a Federal or State Income Tax Return you must have your tax preparer complete your homestead as well.
- We will not be able to process any claim unless all necessary paperwork is brough in at the processing the claim.
- Notice: The Labette County Clerk's Office is not a certified tax preparer.

The purpose of this notice is to inform the public that our office does not offer tax preparation services. For certified tax preparers, please refer to local listings or visit the IRS website for a directory of qualified professionals.
