The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud in the Council Chambers.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids for just cause; such actions will be in accordance with Title 38 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes.

Each bidder must have an active UEI Number, as verified on www.sam.gov, prior to the beginning of construction.

Prime bidders for this work must be licensed under the classification of **Building Construction or Specialty:Swimming Pools**. Any subcontractor submitting a sub-bid in excess of \$50,000 to a Prime Bidder is required to be licensed in accordance with the State of Louisiana requirements.

Each Bidder must deposit with his/her bid, security in the amount, form, and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. Sureties used for obtaining bonds must appear as acceptable on the U. S. Department of Treasury Circular 570.

Negotiable Bid Bonds will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders as soon as possible or not more than 45 days after the opening of bids.

An acceptable Performance Bond and Payment Bond equal to 100% of the contract price will be required of the successful bidder.

There will be a Pre-Bid Conference on this project at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, in the City Hall for the City of Springhill, Louisiana.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The Contractor shall begin mobilization and procurement of materials within ten (10) working days of the receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

The Attention of Bidders is called particularly to the requirements for conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract, Section 3, Segregated Facilities, Executive Order 11246, and all applicable laws and regulations of the Federal government and State of Louisiana and bonding and insurance requirements.

Minority owned firms and small businesses are encouraged to participate. Any person with disabilities requiring special accommodation must contact the City of Springhill no later than seven (7) days prior to bid opening.
