## **ORDINANCE NO. 2024 – 03**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 302.02, SNOW, ICE, DIRT AND RUBBISH AND SECTION 801.04 PUBLIC NUISANCES AFFECTING PEACE AND SAFETY, TO STIPULATE THE SIDEWALKS TO BE MONITORED FOR SNOW REMOVAL

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TRUMAN, MARTIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Section 302.02 Snow, Ice, Dirt and Rubbish, Subd. 1, Duty of Owners and Occupants, and Subd. 2, Removal by City, shall be amended to read as follows:

- Subd. 1. Duty of Owners and Occupants: The owner and the occupant of any property adjacent to a public sidewalk shall use diligence to keep such walk safe for pedestrians. No such owner or occupant shall allow snow, ice, dirt, or rubbish to remain on the walk longer than 48 hours after its deposit.
- Subd. 2. Removal By City. The Street Department shall remove from all through public sidewalks all snow, ice, dirt, and rubbish as soon as possible beginning 48 hours after any such matter has been deposited thereon or after the snow has ceased to fall. A record shall be kept showing the cost of such removal adjacent to each separate lot and parcel and shall deliver such information to the City Clerk.

Section 2. Section 801.04 Public Nuisances Affecting Peace and Safety, Subsection (1), shall be amended to read as follows:

The following are declared to be nuisances affecting public peace and safety:

(1) All snow and ice not removed from through public sidewalks within forty-eight (48) hours after the snow or other precipitation causing the condition has ceased to fall.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.
