To our Customers,

The West Point Municipal Utility has the responsibility to provide its citizens-customers with safe, high quality drinking water and related services. Maintaining a dependable water delivery service at the most affordable price possible is the continuing goal of the West Point Municipal Water System. To accomplish this the Utility Board reviews the utility rates and determines if an increase is needed to protect its financial viability.

On the 15th day of September, 2020 the Utility Board voted to increase the rate by which water consumption is calculated. This increase in the water rate will be a three percent (3%) as recorded by resolution 198-20 effective beginning January 1, 2021.

The previous water rate increase was recorded by resolution 154-11 by the Utility Board on March 16, 2011.

Also included in resolution 198-20 was the directive for the Board to review this rate each year moving forward to determine if the effective rate is adequate to allow the water system to replace aging equipment or sustain any emergent incident that could put the water system in peril. The increase rate is determined by either a Board Determined percent, a percentage determined by the Consumer Price Index or by other additional factors affecting the water system.

The Iowa Rural Water Association (IRWA) and the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) have released a questionnaire regarding Lead and Copper Testing of Drinking Water.
