

COURTROOM DRESS CODE

These rules are not intended to embarrass anyone, but instead they are intended to ensure that persons in the Courtroom do not obstruct or interfere with the transaction of the Court's business in an orderly manner and that they not diminish in any way the dignity of the judicial proceedings.

PROPER DRESS IS REQUIRED IN THE COURTROOM AND IS STRICTLY ENFORCED. If your attire is inappropriate for court, you may either be asked to wait in the hallway until all other cases have been disposed of, or your case may be continued to another date to allow you to assemble appropriate attire for another court appearance.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE COURTROOM:

HATS / HELMETS / DOO-RAGS

TANK TOPS

HALTER TOPS

BARE-MIDRIFF SHIRTS

UNDERSHIRTS AS SHIRTS

SHORTS / CUT-OFFS

FLIP FLOPS / BARE FEET

REVEALING (SEE-THROUGH) CLOTHING

CLOTHING WITH PROFANITY / SIGNS / SYMBOLS

FACE-PAINT / FACIAL PIERCINGS

SLEEPWEAR AS CLOTHING

SWIM WEAR

LINGERIE

ATHLETIC UNIFORMS (GYM OUTFITS)

DRINKS OR FOOD

SMALL CHILDREN are allowed in the Courtroom, but if necessary, you may be asked to wait in the hallway until your case is called.
