

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE NAME OF A CITY PARK;
PRESCRIBING RULES FOR THE USE OF THE PARK; PROVID-
ING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THOSE RULES; FIX-
ING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING CONFLICTING
ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAYNESVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The land owned by the City of Waynesville, which has been developed and is being developed for park and recreation purposes, and which is described as follows, to-wit:

All of the North half of the Southwest quarter and all that part of the South half of the Southwest quarter lying North of a line which constitutes the North boundary of the Original Town of Waynesville, Pulaski County, Missouri and extending West to the center of the Main Channel of Roubidoux Creek; EXCEPT that part of the foregoing described as follows:

(1) All that part on the left Bank of Roubidoux Creek;

(2) All that part lying East of Waynesville-Bartlett Spring Public Road, the location of the said road being as follows: Beginning at a point 20 feet West of the Northwest corner of Block 2 of Original Town of Waynesville, Pulaski County, Missouri; thence North $37^{\circ} 30'$ West 3 chains 11 links; thence North $7^{\circ} 30'$ West 14 chains; thence North 13° East 2 chains; thence North 33° East 3 chains 45 links more or less to half Section line running East and West through Section 24, Township 36 North, Range 12 West of 5th P.M.

(3) All that conveyed to A. A. Dodd by deed recorded in Book 77, Page 14 and described as follows: Beginning at a point 43 links West of the Northeast corner of Block 3 in the Original Town of Waynesville, Pulaski County, Missouri; thence West 2.67 chains along the North boundary of Block; thence North 1.53 chains; thence East 1.90 chains; thence South 28° East 1.72 chains to the point of beginning. All of the foregoing being in Section 24, Township 36 North, Range 12 West of 5th P.M.

is hereby designated and may be referred to as the WAYNESVILLE ROUBIDOUX PARK.

Section 2. The Waynesville Roubidoux Park shall be for the use and benefit of the citizens and inhabitants of the City of Waynesville and for other members of the public, subject always to the rules and restrictions hereinafter set forth and such other rules and regulations as may be established.

Section 3. The following rules shall apply to the Waynesville Roubidoux Park:

A. No vehicle shall be operated at a speed in excess of 10 miles per hour within the Waynesville Roubidoux Park;

B. Motor vehicles, including motorcycles and motor bikes, shall be operated or placed only on the graveled or hard-surfaced areas within Waynesville Roubidoux Park;

C. No person shall be or remain within the Waynesville Roubidoux Park during the period from 10:00 P.M. (prevailing local time) until 6:00 A.M. (prevailing local time) except the Chairman of the Park Board shall have the authority to allow civic groups, under appropriate supervision, to use the Waynesville Roubidoux Park during these proscribed periods of time;

D. Open fires shall be built or maintained only in the cooking pits installed by the City;

E. No trees shall be cut or flowers picked in the Waynesville Roubidoux Park;
