



Board, Commission, and Committee Requirements & Roles

The City of Daingerfield offers various opportunities for residents to serve on boards, commissions, and committees that help guide the city's growth, policies, and services. Below is a summary of the available boards, their roles, and eligibility requirements.

1. Board of Adjustments

Role:

- Hears and decides appeals regarding errors in zoning regulations.
- Considers variances and special exceptions to zoning laws.
- Ensures decisions align with the city's zoning ordinance.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a **resident of Daingerfield**.
 - Cannot have financial or business interests in cases before the board.
 - Must complete **training on zoning laws** within **90 days** of appointment.
 - Must follow **Texas Local Government Code Chapter 211** regarding zoning authority.

2. Daingerfield Economic Development Corporation (4A & 4B)

Role:

- Promotes economic growth and development within Daingerfield.
- Oversees funding and incentives for business development.
- Implements economic strategies in compliance with the Texas Development Corporation Act.

Eligibility Requirements:





- Must meet **residency requirements** outlined in the Texas Development Corporation Act.
 - Must complete **state-mandated economic development training** within **90 days** of appointment for certain positions.
 - Must complete **Open Meetings Act & Public Information Act training**
 - Business, finance, or economic development experience preferred but not required.

3. Planning & Zoning Commission

Role:

- Develops and updates the city's zoning and land use regulations.
- Reviews and approves subdivision plats and land development proposals.
- Advises the City Council on zoning amendments and comprehensive planning.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a **resident of Daingerfield**.
 - Must complete **Open Meetings Act & Public Information Act training**.
 - Must take the **Oath of Office** upon appointment.

4. Ad Hoc Committees

Role:

- Formed for specific projects or temporary city initiatives.
- Provides recommendations to the City Council.
- May focus on special events, policy research, or infrastructure projects.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Varies by committee; requirements will be outlined in appointment notices.
 - Some committees may require expertise in specific fields.

5. Northeast Texas Municipal Water District

Role:

- Oversees water resource management and water supply for Daingerfield.
- Works with regional agencies to ensure sustainable water use.
- Monitors water quality and distribution policies.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a **resident of Daingerfield**
- Expertise in water management, environmental policy, or utilities preferred.

General Requirements for All Boards & Commissions

- ✓ Must be a **registered voter in the City of Daingerfield** (unless otherwise specified).
- ✓ Must **pass a background check** before appointment.
- ✓ Must **attend at least 75% of meetings** and cannot miss **three consecutive meetings**.
- ✓ Must complete **required training** within **90 days** of appointment.
- ✓ Must follow the **City's Ethics Code and Texas conflict of interest laws**.
