RE: Recycling Multi-Unit

Good afternoon Community Partner,

I am reaching out today to notify you of a change that will be happening with your current community recycling bin that is serviced at your location. Currently the 40-cyd Multi-Sort unit is serviced by the Hancock County Solid Waste Management District's Recycling Program. The Board of Hancock County Commissioners, who oversee the Hancock County Solid Waste Management District, are making changes to the recycling program that will eliminate the use of these large containers so you will see changes at your collection site over the <a href="next 5-15 days">next 5-15 days</a>. There may be brief disruption in service however the plan is to have all units updated with containers no later than June 7, 2024. We are excited about these changes and encourage you to continue to support our local community and the recycling efforts.

The Hancock County Commissioners have contracted with Rumpke to provide a collection service that will replace the existing unit on your property. The current blue recycling unit will be removed and replaced with 2-4 single stream 8-cyd collection bins per 40-cyd unit on your site. These new collection bins do not require recyclers to separate the materials for donation and will be serviced by Rumpke. The Hancock County Solid Waste Management District will still oversee the program yet we are confident that these units will be serviced timely and regularly by the 3<sup>rd</sup>-party contractor reducing the onsite debris and contamination. This change in service will be a benefit to your property's appearance as well as improve the resident's ability to recycle more regularly when using the collection bin.

Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding during this transition. With your continued support we believe this program will grow and protect our environment. We look forward to continually working with you to provide recycling opportunities for our neighbors.
