Ordinance Hosting Suggestions and Examples

Many Muni sites are using 3rd party software to host their city ordinances. The ordinance is created within that software and then the link to that software is put on the Ordinance page of the website.

The 3rd party software allows you to organize and create your ordinances in a very organized fashion, then you just place a link to that software on your site.

One such service is eCode360 (<https://www.generalcode.com/online-code/>)

Another is Franklin Legal Publication (<http://www.franklinlegal.net/>)

NOTE: Franklin Legal is now a General Code Company and uses eCode360 to host your ordinances.
