
Responses






2. How long have you lived, owned property, or owned a business in Carefree?




3. What is your age range?




4. What gender do you identify as?




5. Using the "Areas of Carefree" map illustrated below, please indicate which area of Town you currently reside.






7. How important are the following trends Carefree has experienced recently? (check all that apply)

We have 45 acres of state land that could easily be turned into a lovely hiking and bike path. Inexcusable to not get a grant and donations to make that an outdoor recreation area for Carefree. It is easily within walking distance of Civano and Town Center. It just isn't a priority for the our Town Administrator or Economic Development Director who do not even live in Carefree.

Have the Cave Creek&Carefree HY developed to generate income for the Town. STOP ENABLING SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS ON THIS




