

Town License Requirements for Rental Homes

Per Carefree Ordinance Number 2022-03, shortterm/vacation rental owners must obtain and maintain an annual Town license for each Carefree property. This Town of Carefree license is in addition to the county and state requirements.

Also included under A.R.S. §9-500.39 are regulations for residential rentals or "Long-Term Rentals". Long-term rentals are required to register with the Town of Carefree. These properties are



Shaping our Future: General Plan Update



Carefree is embarking on an ambitious endeavor that offers a once-in-ageneration opportunity to shape the future of our beloved town. The General Plan update, a comprehensive and forward-thinking initiative, aims to guide growth and development in Carefree for the years to come.

Since the last General Plan Briefing with the Planning and Zoning Commission held on June 12, 2023, the project team has conducted two more Community Workshops and held a work session with Town Council (August 1, 2023).

Community Workshop #3 focused on diving into General Plan policies from the goals most requested to be removed or revised from the previous workshop. The public was also polled to evaluate the draft vision statement and the General Plan structure.

Community Workshop #4 was centered specifically on Open Space with an external presentation from the Arizona State Land Department. This workshop provided an opportunity to focus on review of the Open Space policies in the General Plan, evaluate open space preferences from the community, and map out areas for potential open space preservation. Collectively, the input from the previous workshops were used to inform the draft document structure and craft a content outline, which is the next component leading up to the drafting of the new General Plan before the required 60-Day Review.

As the General Plan update unfolds, we encourage all residents of Carefree to stay informed and engaged in this vital process. Your participation and input are instrumental in shaping the future of our town. We want to hear from you!

Private Landowner Submits Special Use Permit (SUP) Application for Storage Units

The private landowner of a 1.76 acre commercially zoned parcel at the corner of Cave Creek Road and Bloody Basin Road has submitted to the Town of Carefree a Special Use Permit (SUP) application. This private property owner's request is to construct an indoor-only climate-controlled

storage facility referred to as Carefree Storehouse on this commercially zoned property.

Prior to the submission of this application, as the public review process requires, the property owner conducted two Neighborhood Meetings, collected public input, and made modifications to their plans. Now that this application has been submitted, the Town Staff will begin their technical review process to address ordinance related review. After this technical review pursuant to due process requirements, two public hearings will be publicly scheduled and publicly advertised.

Public participation is encouraged throughout the process, and the Town is eager to hear questions and feedback from the community. Comments related to this property owner's proposal may be submitted to: Stacey@carefree.org.
