## **ORDINANCE NO. 2007-04**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 104 OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE 1985 SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SUBDIVISION COMMITTEE AND DECLARING THAT THE IMMEDIATE OPERATION OF THE PROVISION OF THIS ORDINANCE IS NECESSARY FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH AND SAFETY, THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS, AND THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, ADOPTION AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN AS REQUIRED BY LAW AND DIRECTING THE TOWN CLERK OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE TO INCORPORATE THIS AMENDMENT INTO THE TOWN OF CAREFREE 1985 SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA that:

Section 104 of the Town of Carefree 1985 Subdivision Ordinance is hereby amended to read in its entirety, as follows:

## Section 104. Establishment of the Subdivision Committee.

The Subdivision Committee is established and shall consist of the following members or their duly authorized representatives:

- 1. One member of the Planning and Zoning Commission to be appointed by the Chairman of the Planning & Zoning Commission.
- 2. One Councilmember to be appointed by the Mayor.
- 3. The Town Engineer-Planning Director, who shall serve as Chairman.
- 4. One or two members of the public to be appointed to four year terms by the Council and who shall serve at the pleasure of the Council. All appointments of members of the public shall be for staggered terms of four years each. Members of the public may not serve for more than four (4) consecutive years, but they may be reappointed after the expiration of at least one year between terms.

This amendment shall be incorporated into Article 12-2 of "The Town Code of the Town of Carefree, Arizona", as are other amendments to the Town of Carefree 1985 Subdivision Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED the immediate operation of the provision of this Ordinance is

necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be effective immediately and in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption and approval by the Mayor and the Common Council of the Town of Carefree as required by law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Town Clerk of the Town of Carefree incorporate the Amendment set forth herein into the Town of Carefree 1985 Subdivision Ordinance and The Town Code of the Town of Carefree, Arizona.
