TOWN OF CAREFREE, ARIZONA ORDINANCE NO. 2008-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE 11-3, OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE CODE AMENDED THROUGH NOVEMBER 7, 2007; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEPARABILITY AND DECLARING THAT THE IMMEDIATE OPERATION OF THE PROVISION OF THIS ORDINANCE IS NECESSARY FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH AND SAFETY, THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS, AND THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, ADOPTION AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN AS REQUIRED BY LAW AND DIRECTING THE TOWN CLERK OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE TO INCORPORATE THIS AMENDMENT INTO THE TOWN OF CAREFREE TOWN CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAREFREE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor and Common Council deem it necessary, in order to conserve, promote, and protect the public health, safety and welfare, to amend that certain document known as the Code of the Town of Carefree, Arizona.

<u>Section 2.</u> The amended Code of the Town of Carefree, Arizona shall be known as the "Code of the Town of Carefree, Arizona, amended through January 8, 2008," and is hereby declared to be a public record. Three (3) copies of said amended Code are hereby placed and ordered to remain on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

<u>Section 3.</u> All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

<u>Section 4.</u> The amendments are made to Chapter 11, Article 11-3 of The Town of Carefree Code Amended Through November 7, 2007, as follows (added language is shown in **bold**, deleted language is shown crossed out):

Section 11-3-2 Postings of Signs Pertaining to Elections Permitted INTENTIONALLY LEFT BLANK

A person or political subdivision may erect, place or post in the town rights-of-way temporary political signs. A political sign is a sign supporting the candidacy for office or urging action on any matter on the ballot of any primary, general and special elections. The person or political subdivision responsible for erecting the political signs shall be liable for removal of the political sign from the rights-of-way within seven days after the election to which such signs relate.

<u>Section 5.</u> The immediate operation of the provision of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be effective immediately and in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption and approval by the Mayor and the Common Council of the Town of Carefree as required by law.

<u>Section 6.</u> The Town Clerk of the Town of Carefree shall incorporate the Amendment set forth herein into the Town Code of the Town of Carefree, Arizona.
