RESOLUTION 2019-08**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CAREFREE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA,
ADOPTING THE UNIFORM VIDEO LICENSE AGREEMENT AND APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, On May 17, 2018, the Governor of the State of Arizona signed into law that Legislation enacting the Uniform Video Service License legislation (SB1140) amending Title 9, Arizona Revised Statutes, by adding Chapter 12; amending Section 41-1092.01, Arizona Revised Statutes; relating to video and cable service providers which requires cities and towns to adopt a standard agreement and application for cable providers by July 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Once adopted, from January 1, 2020 until June 30, 2020 current cable operators may elect to continue to operate pursuant to their existing local licenses or terminate the previous local license and apply for a uniform video service license; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Carefree is mandated to issue the uniform license to the applicant 30 days after the filing of a completed application and affidavit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Carefree, Arizona, in compliance with ARS 42-17105(A), as follows:

That the Uniform Video Service License Agreement and the Uniform Video Application attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B" are adopted as a standard agreement and application for cable providers in the Town of Carefree.


