TO: Cash Special Utility District Customers

In 2024 the District sold 10.5 million dollars in construction bonds to fund two projects on the west side distribution system, a 1-million-gallon ground storage tank at the Fate Pump Station, and a new Union Valley Pump Station. Both projects are completed in the summer of 2025 and put into service. The next round of projects includes a 1-million-gallon ground storage tank at the water treatment plant, new raw water pump station, and new transmission watermain. Cost estimates for the next round of projects is 15.5 million dollars and will be funded through the sale of bonds as well.

Other projects being completed in 2026 include a new Distribution Office, recoating Dixon water tower, Lone Oak tower, and ground storage tanks, which will all be funded with capital improvement monies set aside through the sale of new meters.

The Board of Directors are determined to meet the growing needs of our customers, continue to improve services, and maintain the existing investment in our infrastructure. In order to fund these projects, the Board approved a five-year rate plan and schedule in 2023. The only variables in the plan are inflation over 3% and the cost of purchased water.

Therefore, in order to fund current projects, repairs and maintenance, and the capital improvement program to meet the needs of our customers, as well as keeping the District financially stable, the Board of Directors has approved the following increase in the rates.
