Residents of Cass County,

In order to keep our Cass County Citizens notified of all emergencies, The Cass County Emergency Management Office along with the Cass County Sheriff's Office, is encouraging all Cass County Citizens to sign up for the CodeRED Alert System. What is Code RED? CodeRED is the emergency notification system Cass County uses to inform residents of emergencies. Once activated, the system will attempt to contact citizens up to three times and will leave messages in voicemail boxes and on answering machines. Messages can be sent to the entire county or to selected areas or neighborhoods based on where the incident may be occurring.

## What is CodeRED used for?

CodeRED alerts are issued for a variety of situations, including natural disasters, terrorism threats, gas leaks, water contamination, chemical spills, missing child alerts, severe weather such as tornadoes and flash flooding, and for general community notifications. When you sign up for CodeRED alerts you are choosing to receive emergency alerts issued by county officials; you may also choose to receive these optional alerts:

- Severe weather warnings issued by the National Weather Service:
  - o Tornado
  - Severe Thunderstorm
  - Flash Flood
- General notifications (example: change in garbage pick-up schedule) Sign up for CodeRED

In order to sign up for CodeRED please type in and search <a href="www.CassCountyND.gov/Alerts">www.CassCountyND.gov/Alerts</a> and click on the red box 'Sign Up for CodeRED alerts' to bring up the CodeRED enrollment web page.

Please assist family, friends, and neighbors in signing up for the CodeRED system if they are unable to do so themselves. Residents can also call the Cass County Emergency Management Office at (701) 476-4068 for assistance. Thanks for your assistance in making our community a safer place to live.
