Please join the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Southwest Region for a live Public Involvement Meeting to discuss the proposed improvements taking place on WIS 89 (E Madison Street) from the Waterloo East Limit to the Mauneshia River Bridge in the City of Waterloo, Jefferson County. The meeting will be held at **5:00 p.m., Monday, August 25, 2025** at the City of Waterloo City Hall. A short presentation will occur at 5:15 p.m. The intent of this meeting is to review the purpose and need for improvements, present the proposed improvements, obtain comments and feedback on the proposed improvements, discuss the project schedule and traffic impacts, and review WisDOT's tools for businesses in work zones.

Project staff will share maps, displays and exhibits via a live presentation. A comment, question, and answer period will follow the live presentation.

This project includes replacing the existing pavement, base aggregate, curb and gutter, sidewalks, storm sewer and street lighting. Construction is tentatively scheduled for 2028. Sanitary sewer and water main will be replaced by the City of Waterloo prior to this project. Traffic impacts include a full closure with detour of vehicular traffic and pedestrian staging within the corridor to maintain access to adjacent properties.
