Town of West Milford April Newsletter 2025

Reminder: Fire Season is still in effect until May 31, 2024, 5:00pm Burn Law March 1-May 31 No burning from 7:00am-5:00pm, Fire must be attended to at all times and fully extinguished when leaving it. The immediate area must be cleared and have a minimum of 10 feet of mineral soil of what is being burned. The only items permitted to be burned are grass, leaves and vegetation rubbish **No** lumber, cardboard or trash is to be burnt Contact the fire department at 304-745-3355 with any questions prior to burning

Building Code Ordinance: It is required to obtain a Building Permit prior to any remodeling, roofing, painting or electrical work Contractors are required to obtain a Business License at City Building This protects each citizen from a contractor not completing a job. The contractor also needs to produce a Certificate of Insurance. For more information contact Code Enforcement Officer Vincent Smith at 304-476-0070

Leash Law Ordinance: All dogs are required to be on a leash. Harrison County Animal Control will be picking up any unleashed dogs and will be treated as a stray dog. The owner of the pet is also subject to fines assessed by the Town as well as Animal Control

Water Project: Currently, 4 Fire hydrants are being replaced. This is by using the ARPA funds made available by the county commission and funds from the town water account. The contractor hopes to have this project completed the first week of April as weather permits. Boil Water Advisories will be issued as necessary

The main project is selected to start after April 7. This will include 3 phases with 3 different contractors. USDA will award the funds to the town on Monday, April 7 at 10am at the Community Building. Contractors will work with Thrasher to begin the project at this time. During this project there will be periods of water interruption and boil water advisories and repairs are made to the main line valves, master pit area and to the Water tank. We apologize for any inconvenience.

All residents are encouraged to sign up for the Alerts as Daily alerts will be made available We will keep everyone up-to-date via facebook page as well as the Emergency Alert Text and Email program. If you haven't signed up for the free service now is the time.

Emergency Notification System

The town now has a way to Mass communicate with residents and or family members who reside in West Milford or out of state who want to be kept up to date on various activities in the town. These can be notifications for *Water Breaks, Boil Water Advisories, Weather related emergencies, Neighborhood Watch, Weather related emergencies and General activities in the community*. The system is called WENS-Wireless Emergency Notification System. This is a <u>FREE</u> service. However, you will need to sign-up for this free service. You will receive email and/or text messages to what is occurring in our community. To signup, Type the following into your browser to get started:

alerts.harrisoncountywv.com

This will bring up a screen showing "Harrison County Alerts" choose <u>West Milford</u>, you will then receive a screen that will allow you to enter your information, then click on the items that you would like to receive emails or text messages to alert you to whatever is occurring in the community. Once you have completed the items you are interested in receiving information for, scroll down and complete your registration.

Emails and text messages will come from an acronym WMWS-Which is short for West Milford Water System.

This service is being provided to us by Harrison County Commission and the Harrison County Office of Emergency Management.
