	Vice Mayor Worth made clear that this ordinance, as with any ordinance, could be revisited and revised in the future.									
	Councilmember Moore said waiting and seeing what happens with the new statute across the state is a good idea.									
	Ms. Barber said yes, this ordinance can be changed later to be more beneficial to Jerome, and the way it is written now is what benefits Jerome now
