The Labette County Commissioners are asking for input from Labette County residents concerning RWE's proposal to construct a wind farm. The Board of County Commissioners will not be answering any questions or making comments. This hearing is only for input from Labette County residents.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, all attendees are required to wear a mask and remain socially distant per Governor's Executive Order. Those who do not have a mask will be provided one. Failure to properly wear a mask or remain socially distant may result in removal from the building. The Labette County Sheriffs Office will be present to assist and provide security. Please be aware that the hearing is on public school grounds and firearms are not permitted.

Only Labette County residents will be allowed to speak. Those Labette County residents who wish to speak will only be allowed to speak once, and there will be a 3-minute time limit. If you do wish to speak, you will be asked to give your name and address before speaking. Vulgar comments, obscene language, and repetitive statements are not permitted. Repetitive statements are not allowed, to further give every resident a chance to speak if they choose.
